### Guidelines for entry

2. Entries must be submitted in **landscape on A4 size white paper**.
3. The following information must be included on the reverse side of each submission:

**Student's name,

and school address.**

4. Each entrant agrees to their details (name and age) being used in promotional material for Mental Health Ireland.
5. Closing date for entries is **Friday, 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2016**.
