HSE - Counselling and Psychotherapy for Adults who experienced childhood abuse or neglect (CaPA)	The CaPA service for Adults who experienced childhood abuse or neglect provides trauma-informed counselling/therapy from NCS centres nationwide. There are 10 main centres located across the country and some additional outreach/satellite centres. Counselling is available in person, online via video or on the phone and provided free. Counsellors are all accredited with the Irish Association of Counselling and Psychotherapy (IACP).  Self-referral is accepted as are referrals from healthcare providers such as GPs.
